According to the Council Regulation provisions no. 2679/98/CE, regarding the internal market operation referring to the free goods circulation between the Member States, Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure, notifies the national roads users from Romania, the following:

The National Company of Motorways and National Roads in Romania notifies the traffic participants that starting with **26.07.2012, at 18⁰⁰ hrs. until 26.10.2012, the circulation on DN 39 Constanta-Mangalia will be restricted at km 8+988 – „AGIGEA BRIDGE”, for the motorvehicles with the total maximum allowed weight over 5 tons, excepting those which perform passengers transport activities.**

We like to mention that the **travelling maximum speed for the road traffic will be restricted to 30 km/hour.**

The traffic restriction is necessary due to the execution of the bridge rehabilitation works, respectively the consolidation of the bracing wires belonging to the resistance structure.

During this restriction period, the circulation of the vehicles with the total maximum allowed weight over 5 tons may be carried out on the following bypasses:

On the route: București –Constanța Sud Port – Agigea – Negru Vodă – Mangalia and return:

- **A 2 (București – Cernavodă – Medgidia Interchange) – DJ¹ 381 (Medgidia Interchange - Ciocârlia de Sus) – DN 3 (Ciocârlia de Sus – Cobadin) - DJ 321 (Cobadin – Mereni) - DJ 391(Mereni – Topraisar) - DN 38 (Topraisar – Agigea) – DN² 39 (Agigea – Mangalia) and return.**

On the route: Hârșova (DN 2A) - Tulcea (DN 22) - Port Constanța Sud – Agigea – Negru Vodă – Mangalia and return

- **A 4 (Ovidiu Interchange – Interchange between A 4 and A 2) – A 2 (Interchange A 4 with A 2 - Medgidia Interchange)_ - DJ 381 (Interchange Medgidia - Ciocârlia de Sus) – DN 3 (Ciocârlia de Sus – Cobadin) - DJ 321 (Cobadin – Mereni) - DJ 391 (Mereni – Topraisar) - DN 38 (Topraisar – Agigea) - DN 39 (Agigea – Mangalia) and return.**

The drivers are asked to observe the road circulation restriction and the temporary roads signing.
